1. Is it possible for the Damask sample that will be provided to those in attendance include a full repeat?

Answer: Samples were provided to those in attendance

2. Clarify the requirements of Inside Delivery.

Answer: Inside delivery is not required.

3. Will orders placed against contract be subject to a Variation in Quantity, ie +/- 10% or will exact quantities have to be shipped?

Answer: Variation is subject to a variation in quantity of +/- 5%.

4. Can you provide past procurement history on these items to include contractor, price per yard and quantities ordered at one time.

Answer: No

5. Would orders issued against contract be for minimum dye lots per pattern and color not to exceed 1000 yards or would contractor be subject to possibly supplying small quantities at times?

Answer: We would like the ability to order in quantities of 500 yards. However, if your economic run is in quantities of 1,000 yards please state that in your proposal or whatever your economic run quantity is.

6. Will contract be awarded as an all or none or by line?

7. Based on a 5 year contract period with two 1 year options would an economic price adjustment be available or would the awarded price remain the same for the contract period?
